Neges gan Gadeirydd y Llywodraethwyr

Mae'n bleser mawr gennyf gyflwyno ein hadroddiad ar gyfer blwyddyn academaidd 2023-2024 i chi. Dros y flwyddyn ddiwethaf, maeaelodau'r Corff Llywodraethol wedi parhau i herio a chefnogi'r ysgol i sicrhau bod ansawdd yr addysg a ddarperir i'ch plant o'r safon uchaf. Mae llywodraethu yn rôl ddi-dâl ac mae ein llywodraethwyr yn gwirfoddoli ochr yn ochr ag ymrwymiadau gwaith, teulu a phersonol. Diolch i Mrs E Howard a Mrs H Watkins am eu cyfraniad i'r ysgol yn ystod eu cyfnod fel llywodraethwyr. Ar adeg ysgrifennu'r adroddiad hwn, mae gan y Corff Llywodraethu ddu le gwag ar gyfer rhiant-llywodraethwyr, a chaiff y rhain eu llenwi'r tymor hwn gan ddefnyddio'r broses arferol.

Fel llywodraethwyr, mae gennym gyfrifoldeb i weithio gyda'r Pennaeth, yr Uwch Dîm Arwain a staff i ddarparu amgylchedd dysgu cyffrous a bywiog i ddisgyblion yr ysgol. Mae ein cyfrifoldebau'n cynnwys sicrhau bod y gyllideb yn cael ei gwario'n ddoeth a bod staffio'n briodol. Mae'r llywodraethwyr yn monitro gwariant yn ofalus ac fel ysgol, rydym yn cyflawni gwerth rhagorol am arian. Rydym yn parhau i fod yn destun toriadau yn y gyllideb gan yr awdurdod lleol, ac mae'n anochel y bydd hyn yn effeithio ar rai meysydd o'r ysgol. Rydym hefyd yn gyfrifol am fwytan iach, eiddo ac iechyd a diogelwch yn yr ysgol. Rydym yn parhau i ariannu datblygiadau i'r ardaloedd awyr agored er budd ein disgyblion a'n staff, a dangosir rhai lluniau ar ddiwedd yr adroddiad hwn. Mae'r corff llywodraethu wedi penodi llywodraethwyr cyswllt yn unol â'r blaenoriaethau a amlinellir yng Nghynllun Datblygu'r Ysgol i'w monitro a'u gwerthuso drwy gydol y flwyddyn. Rydym yn monitro presenoldeb a diogelu yn rheolaidd.

Eleni, mae'r disgyblion wedi mwynhau hyd yn oed mwy o ymglymiad cymunedol a theithiau a gweithgareddau ysgol. Mae'n braf gweld parhad y sesiwn 'Ti a Fi' i fabanod a phlant bach ar fore dydd Mawrth yn yr ysgol. Mae gwensi Sbaeneg a cherddoriaeth a chlybiau ar ôl ysgol hefyd yn parhau i gael eu cynnal, ac mae nifer dda o ddisgyblion yn manteisio arnynt. Hoffem ddiolch i chi, fel rhieni a gofalwyr, am barhau i gefnogi gweithgareddau o'r fath yn yr ysgol, gan ein bod yn credu bod y rhain i gyd yn brofiadau allweddol i'r plant, a'u bod yn rhai y byddant yn eu cofio am flynyddoedd i ddod. Rydym am ddiolch yn fawr iawn hefyd i'r Ffrindiau am eu holl ymdrechion codi arian hyd yma eleni, gyda gweithgareddau cyffrous iawn i'r plant. Fel rhieni, fe'ch gwahoddir i'r ysgol yn rheolaidd i weld y gwaith mae eich plant/plentyn yn ei gynhyrchu, ac i gyd-ymfalchiö yn eu campau.

Rydym yn parhau i weithio gyda'r awdurdod lleol mewn perthynas â'n hadeilad ysgol newydd yn Ffordd Cadfan. Yn anffodus, mae'r cynnydd wedi'i rwystro hyd yma gan adroddiadau ecolegol a biwrocratiaeth, ond rydym yn parhau i fonitro'r cynnydd fel Corff Llywodraethu, ac mae'r gwaith adeiladu yn dal i fod i fynd rhagddo.

Mae'r ysgol yn cyfathrebu gyda rhieni/gofalwyr trwy alwadau ffôn, y system negeseuon testun, y wefan a'r grŵp Facebook caeedig. Yn y byd sydd ohoni, mae'r ysgol yn parhau i gefnogi pob aelod o gymuned yr ysgol ac yn parhau i ariannu darpariaeth fel ELSA, Thrive, cymorth galw heibio rhieni/gofalwyr a sesiynau lles. Mae'r ysgol yn cynnig gwisg ysgol ail-law am ddim yn y dderbynfa, sydd ar agor yn ystod oriau ysgol i bob rhiant.

Message from the Chair of Governors

It gives me great pleasure to present to you our report for the academic year 2023-2024. Over the past year, members of the Governing Body have continued to challenge and support the school to ensure that the quality of education provided for your children is of the highest standard. Governance is an unpaid role and our governors volunteer alongside work, family and personal commitments. Our governors come from a variety of backgrounds and use their skills, knowledge and expertise to ensure that the school is the best it can be and that it plays an active part in the cluster and community. Governors meet regularly and complete development training as standard. This year we have welcomed the following new governors: Mrs R Senior and Mr M Stephens. Thank you to Mrs E Howard and Mrs H Watkins for their contribution to the school during their time as governors. At the time of writing the Governing Body is holding two parent governor vacancies and these will be filled by the usual process this term.

As Governors we have a responsibility to work with the Headteacher, Senior Leadership Team and staff to provide an exciting and vibrant learning environment for the pupils at the school. Our responsibilities include ensuring that the budget is spent wisely and that staffing is appropriate. Governors monitor spending carefully and as a school we achieve excellent value for money. We continue to be subject to budget cuts from the local authority and this will inevitably impact some areas of the school. We are also responsible for the healthy eating, premises and health & safety at the school. We continue to fund developments to the outdoor areas for the benefit of our pupils and staff and some photographs are shown at the end of this report. The governing body has appointed link governors in line with the priorities outlined in the School Development Plan to monitor and evaluate throughout the year. We monitor attendance and safeguarding regularly.

This year the pupils have enjoyed even more community involvement and school trips and activities. It is great to see the continuation of the school 'Ti a Fi' baby and toddler session on Tuesday mornings at the school, Spanish and music lessons After-school clubs continue and are well attended. We thank you, as parents and carers, for continuing to support such school activities, as we firmly believe that these are all key experiences for the children and ones which they will remember for years to come. A big thank you also to Ffrindiau for all their fundraising efforts this year to date with some very exciting activities for the children. As parents, you are regularly invited into school to see the work produced by your child(ren) and to share in their achievements.

We continue to work with the local authority in respect of our planned new school build at Ffordd Cadfan. Unfortunately progress has been hindered to date by ecology reports and red tape, but we continue to monitor progress as a Governing Body and the build is still planned to proceed.

The school communicates with parents/carers via phone calls, the text messaging system, website and closed Facebook group. In today's climate, the school continues to support all members of the school community and continues to fund provision such as ELSA, Thrive, parent/carer drop-in support and wellbeing sessions. The school offers a free of charge preloved uniform rail at reception, which is open during school hours to all parents.

Please stay safe and well in the current times and do not hesitate to contact the school if you require any further support, whether academic or pastoral/personal. Thank you once again for your continued support for our school and your children.

3. DATA AR BERFFORMIAD / PERFORMANCE DATA

Mae data yn fewnol ar gyfer rhesymau cynnydd ac ymyraethau. Mae canlyniadau Asesiadau Personol Cenedlaethol yn cael eu rhannu gyda rhieni ac yn cael eu dadansoddi'n fewnol.

Mae tîm yr ysgol yn monitro cynnydd holl ddisgyblion Bro Ogwr ar adegau rheolaidd ac amserol. Mae llywodraethwyr yn parhau i fonitro cynnydd mewnol trwy'r is-bwylgor Cwricwlwm, Data a Safonau a thrwy gyswilt agos â'n Partner Gwella Consortiwm Canolbarth y De, Mr Duan Evans. Mae'r corff llywodraethu wedi penodi llywodraethwyr cyswilt yn unol â'r blaenoriaethau a amlinellir yn y Cynllun Datblygu Ysgol i fonitro a gwerthuso yn ystod y flwyddyn.

All data is internal for progress and intervention purposes. National Individual Personal Assessment results for pupils in years 2 – 6 are shared with parents and internally analysed. The school team monitors the progress of all pupils at Bro Ogwr at regular stages and time frames. Governors continue to monitor internal progress through the Curriculum, Data and Standards sub-committee and through close liaison with our Central South Consortium Improvement Partner, Mr Duan Evans. The governing body has appointed link governors in line with the priorities outlined in the School Development Plan to monitor and evaluate throughout the year.

4. PRESENOLDEB / ATTENDANCE

Rydym yn annog rhieni/gofalwyr i weithio gyda'r ysgol i sicrhau bod disgyblion yn mynychu'r ysgol yn ddyddiol ac yn brydlon a chyfyngu ar wyliau yn ystod y tymor lle bo modd. Mae ein gweithdrefnau diogelu yn cynnwys cyswilt dyddiol ar gyfer y rhai nad ydynt yn mynychu'r ysgol a darperir cymorth lle bo'n briodol i wella presenoldeb a phrydlondeb, a all gynnwys cyfeirio at asiantaethau allanol os oes angen. Mae presenoldeb yn cael ei fonitro'n barhaus gan y Pennaeth a'r Uwch Dîm Arweinyddiaeth mewn cysylltiad â'n Swyddog Lles Addysg a'n llywodraethwr cyswilt ar gyfer y maes hwn.

We encourage parents/carers to work with the school to ensure that pupils attend school daily and punctually and limit holidays during term time where possible. Our safeguarding procedures include daily contact for non-attendees to school and support is provided where appropriate to improve attendance and punctuality, which may include referral to outside agencies if required. Attendance is continually monitored by the Headteacher and Senior Leadership Team in liaison with our Education Welfare Officer and our link governor for this area.

5. GWEITHGAREDDAU CHWARAEON AC ALLGYRSIOL / SPORTING AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Mae'r ysgol wedi cymryd rhan lawn a gweithgar mewn llawer o weithgareddau chwaraeon ac allgyrsiol o fewn y sir ynghyd â chystadlaethau Cenedlaethol a rhai a drefnir gan Urdd Gobaith Cymru. Mae gwybodaeth am weithgareddau allgyrsiol a chwaraeon yn cael ei chyfathrebu'n eang gan yr ysgol; caiff rhieni eu diweddu'n rheolaidd gyda digwyddiadau a chyflawniadau a gallant ddilyn digwyddiadau ar X (eisoes yn cael ei alw'n Trydar) lle bo modd. Mae llywodraethwyr yn rhoi diolch i staff a rhieni am eu cefnogaeth i ddigwyddiadau allgyrsiol eleni ac fel ysgol rydym yn parhau i ddathlu llwyddiannau lu yn y maes hwn.

The school has taken a full and active part in many sporting and extracurricular activities within the county along with National competitions and those organised by Urdd Gobaith Cymru. Information about extracurricular and sporting activities are widely communicated by the school; parents are regularly updated with events and achievements and are able to follow events on X (previously known as Twitter) where possible or access the school website for half termly newsletters. Governors thank staff and parents for their support of extracurricular events this year and as a school we continue to celebrate many successes in this area.



14. CATEGORI IAITH A DEFNYDD O'R GYMRAEG / LANGUAGE CATEGORY AND USE OF THE WELSH LANGUAGE

Ysgol cyfrwng Cymraeg yw Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr. Y Gymraeg yw iaith swyddogol yr ysgol. O'r Meithrin hyd at flwyddyn 2 addysgir pob pwnc trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg. O flwyddyn 3 i 6 addysgir pynciau trwy gyfrwng y Gymraeg heblaw am Saesneg, a gyflwynir ym Mlwyddyn 3.

Ysgol Gymraeg Bro Ogwr is a Welsh medium school. The Welsh language is the official language of the school. From Nursery to Year 2 all subjects are taught through the medium of Welsh. In Years 3 to 6 subjects are taught through the medium of Welsh apart from English, which is introduced in Year 3.

Mae'r cyfleusterau wedi'u lleoli ym mhrif adeilad yr ysgol a hefyd yn y cabanau sydd wedi'u lleoli y tu ôl i adeilad yr ysgol. Mae'r plant yn dda am edrych ar ôl ardaloedd yr holl doiledu ar y cyfan. Mae'r toiledau'n cael eu glanhau'n ddyddiol gan y Gwasanaethau Glanhau Corfforaethol a gyflogir yn yr ysgol. Mae unrhyw faterion gweithredol neu lanhau yn ystod y diwrnod ysgol yn cael sylw prydol gan staff yr ysgol.

There is adequate provision of toilet facilities for all pupils from Nursery to Year 2. All the facilities are located within the main school building. The number of toilets available is adequate for the number of pupils in Years 3 to 6. There are separate, adequate facilities for boys and girls in these year groups. The facilities are located within the main school building

and also in the demountable buildings situated at the rear of the school building. All toilet areas are generally well looked after by the pupils. The toilets are cleaned daily by the Corporate Cleaning Services employed by the school. Any operational or cleaning issues during the school day are addressed promptly by school staff.

16. BWYTA’N IACH / HEALTHY EATING

Daeth y “Mesur Bwyta’n Iach mewn Ysgolion” i rym ddydd Llun 2 Medi 2013. Mae'r Ysgol wedi derbyn dystysgrif gan yr Awdurdod yn nodi bod y fwydlen a ddarperir gan Wasanaethau Arwyo'r Awdurdod yn cydymffurfio'n llawn â'r safonau a nodir yn nogfen Llywodraeth Cymru “Blas am Oes”. Mae llywodraethwyr yn trafod yr elfen hon o'r cwricwlwm gyda staff allweddol yr ysgol ac o 2022 ymlaen bydd yn cynnwys yr elfen hon yn ei monitro drwy gydol y flwyddyn ysgol.

The “Healthy Eating in Schools Measure” came into force on Monday 2nd September 2013. The School has received a certificate from the Authority stating that the menu provided by the Authority’s Catering Services is fully compliant with the standards set out in the Welsh Government document “Appetite for Life”. Governors discuss this element of the curriculum with key school staff and from 2022 onwards will include this element in its monitoring throughout the school year.
